Under the International Fire Code (IFC) adopted November 2006 by the City of Hondo, Chapter 3, Section 307, Open Burning and Recreational Fire, the following sections will apply: Section 307.1, 307.2, 307.2.1, 307.2.2, 307.3, 307.3.1, 307.3.2, and 307.4. Also, Chapter 1, Section 105.6.31, Open Burning, shall be adhered to. Under the Hondo Code of Ordinances, Article 5.300, Outdoor Burning, and the rules and regulations of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, (TCEQ), will apply. Any person requesting to burn within the city limits of Hondo shall first be required to obtain a burn permit in writing for such fire from the Fire Marshal. Said permit shall be issued only if in the opinion of the Fire Marshal, the time and place of said fire is not dangerous to adjoining property and shall be supervised by the person obtaining the permit and they shall not leave the fire unguarded at any time while it is burning. Precautionary measures shall be taken by the person in charge of the burn by having at least one garden hose hooked to a water supply and readily available. The Chief of the Hondo Volunteer Fire Company shall be notified either written or verbally of the impending burn and the Sheriff's Office dispatcher shall be informed as to time and place of the burn prior to the start of the fire by at least one hour.
